



Ancient Egyptians Harvest Scene

- 1. The reapers; 2. A reaper drinking from a cup; 3, 4. Gleaners—the first of these asks to allow him to drink;
- 5. Carrying the ears in a rope basket—the length of the stubble showing the ears alone are cut off;
- 8. Winnowing; 10. The *tritura*, answering to our threshing; 12. Drinks from a water-skin suspended in a tree;
- 14. Scribe who notes down the number of bushels measured from the heap;
- 16. Checks the account by noting those taken away to the granary.
