

A finely-executed bronze figure of Har-Oeri, son of Osiris and Athor, who is frequently called the elder Horus. At Ombos he is styled "Resident in the eyes of light, Lord of Ombos, the great God, Lord of the Heavens, Lord of Eelak, Phile," etc., and is evidently connected with the Sun. From Memphis.
