

Ancient Egyptians pounding various substances in mortars with metal pestles.—From Thebes. $a \ g \ i$, mortars. $d \ d$, pestles. Figs. 1 and 2, alternately raising and letting fall the pestles into the mortar. Figs. 3 and 4, sifting the substance after it is pounded; the coarser parts, h, being returned into the mortar to be again pounded.
