



Ancient Egyptian Necklaces.

A, a suspension of small rounded eggs, or bronze pils. B is the other end of A. These leaves are of gold, filled with beads (small and green and red stones). M is a sort of gold fungus or chain of which a shank ornament found in gold forms the centre or ornament. U, is the pectoral of the late Mr. No. 10. V W X Y Z, gold necklaces, one sliding into the other.
