

Coin of Judæa struck under Pontius Pilate.

Obverse: τιβερίου Καίσαρος ("Of Tiberius Cæsar"), with the legend 15 16, i. e. A.D. 29, the year of our Lord's crucifixion. Reverse: Τουλία Καίσαρος ("Julia [mother] of Cæsar"), with three ears of corn tied together. Probably a quadrans, equivalent to two "mites" (Matt. xi, 29).
