



Coin of Judæa struck under Pontius Pilate.

Obverse: Τιβερίου Καίσαρος ("Of Tiberius Cæsar"), with the legend 45 16, i. e. A.D. 29, the year of our Lord's crucifixion. *Reverse*: Ἰουλία Καίσαρος ("Julia [mother] of Cæsar"), with three ears of corn tied together. Probably a *quadrans*, equivalent to two "mites" (Matt. xi, 29).
